





Alternatives for accessing Burnaby Public Library from Hastings











Direct pedestrian access is established from Hastings to the Burnaby Public Library. A pedestrian only area is also created with existing parking being removed from the interior of the institutional zone. These strategies are intended to reclaim land around the existing institutions to make them more approachable for people walking from Hastings.

Direct pedestrian access is established from Hastings to the Burnaby Public Library. Existing houses fronting the institutional zone will transition from single family housing into seniors club houses, medical clinics, counselling centres, and other service providing buildings. These buildings need to adjust to the new atmosphere of the park, but maintain a residential character to contrast the larger institutions beyond.
