Potential use of the the diverse pathway system around schools


















The new alleyway would be principally pedestrian oriented. Requisite delivery, garbage pick-up and other vehicular service could occur at off hours. Minmal garbage producing establishments could have curbside service on Hastings and Albert Streets. New mult-family buildings could conceal their larger garbage bins in alcoves.


Residential parking, for multi-family units located along the alley would be below grade and accessible from Hastings and Albert Streets.













north - south transect : diversity of uses and types group 3 : the hastings experience





