Assignment two: Master Plan.

Students are to collaborate in their teams to produce a single and explicit master plan for the district.

Master plan should include Hastings Street and the 500 meters to the north and south.

In this area students are to show the locations for 15,000 people in 7,500 additional units.

Also to be included are the locations for 6,000 new jobs (@ 150 sq feet per job).

Finally, teams are to include an additional 500,000 sq feet of commercial space. This amount of commercial space will absorb 2,500 of the jobs.

The final scale for the project will be 3,000 scale and one base map for each of the five teams will be provided. Final plans will be drawn on the base sheets in the manner illustrated in this example.
